



Keeping staff and participants safe

Our staff and participants are extremely important to us at the Center. Our priority is the health and safety of our staff and your loved one. In order to provide the highest standard of safety, the following measures will be followed during this time of crisis.

What we are doing:

- Temperature checks at door along with a visual health assessment for EVERYONE entering the center
- Hand and walker/wheelchair sanitation upon building entry for EVERYONE
- Frequent sanitation of bathrooms, handles, knobs, fixtures
- Daily sanitation of tables and chairs
- Frequent sanitation of high touch areas such as door knobs/handles, copiers, phones, sinks and faucets, etc.
- Social distancing between participants, each participant sits at their own table that only they use
- Creating smaller groups of participants, each group in their own dedicated space
- Spacing out bathroom trips to minimize the number of people in the bathroom, or traveling to or from the bathroom at once
- Frequent hand washing and hand sanitation for all staff and participants
- Face masks worn whenever within 6 feet of another person
- Gloves when appropriate for assistance with bathroom needs or other appropriate activities
- Restricting visitors to the Center
- Limiting in person contact within the Center when possible
- Isolating any staff member or participant that show any sign of illness until they can leave the building
